

How to manually connect to ULG-Student WIFI on Windows 10


1. Right click on Wifi icon > Open Network & Internet Settings.




2. Click Network and Sharing Center



3. Click Set up a new connection or network




4. Click Manually connects to a wireless network, then click next.




- 5. Under Information for the wireless network you want to add
- a) Enter ULG-Student into the Network name field.
- b) Select WPA2---Enterprise in the Security type dropdown menu.
- c) Select **AES** in the **Encryption type** dropdown menu.
- d) Check to select Start this connection automatically.


e) Click Next.




6. Click **Change connection settings**.




7. The **Connection** tab should look like this:




8. Click on the **Security** tab, then **Settings**.



9. Uncheck **Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate**, then click the **Configure** button.




10. Make sure the Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any) checkbox is unchecked. Finally click **OK**.




11. Click **OK** to close Protected EAP Properties.

12. In the Security tab, click on Advanced Settings.



13. Check Specify Authentication mode and choose User Authentication. Click OK.



- 14. Click **OK** to close **ULG-Student** Wireless Network properties.
- 15. Click **Close** to complete the setup.

A network dialog box will appear. If not, find the WiFi called **ULG-Student**. Enter your username and password (same as your email account). And then click **OK**. The username should be "student\your student ID" (student\ULG14660 for example)
